

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


HERCULES

The mythical Greek Gods of yore are left homeless when Mount Olympus is foreclosed upon in the midst of yet another Greek Economic Crisis.

Now out of the sky and on to the streets, they seek refuge in the home of a PhD student named Agatha. In exchange for aiding the gods assimilate to Earth, Zeus promises to give her the missing piece to an ancient Greek artefact that is kept on Mount Olympus.

With only limited godly powers, the Greek Gods will have to learn how to adapt to life on earth...but how do you explain a 5000-year gap in your CV when you're the God of Thunder applying for a weatherman job? Agatha does all that she can to help Zeus try and reclaim Mount Olympus, but when this dysfunctional family can't even take out the trash, how will they be convinced to return to their divine responsibilities?

What You'll See Each Week

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Throughout the series, this ungodly bunch will run amok in the (below) average city of Athens, USA and shake up the humdrum life of their host Agatha. With sheer entitlement and cluelessness, we will watch our washed-up gods try (and ultimately fail) to, well, fit in.

From applying to jobs and signing up to dating sites, to hiding your incestuous affair from your boss and impregnating a dolphin during a whirlwind romance, they'll learn (or not) to live as humans. Along the way we see will see the Ungodly squad encounter both friends and foe from Greek mythology, such as:



Medusa (a dispensary owner who *gets* people stoned rather than turned into stone)
Cupid (a degenerate bar-fly who's out of work due to the recent rise of dating apps)
Dionysos (a fraternity legend,

party animal and butt-chugging advocate)

ASTHA ATTHA

A nerd for all things Greek mythology, Agatha is initially starstruck at the sight of her heroesthe gods. That's until she learns that they're absolutely *psychotic*.

"Forecast calls for above-average familial disappointment with a 90% chance of me wondering where my eternal life went wrong" - Zeus





"Just because you and I are siblings that happened to be married it does not make our son a 'Gross Domestic Product'!" -Hera



"Hello Dad? It's me, your son. No, your other son. No, your other, OTHER son. No..." -Hercules




ATHENS, USA




2. Are You There, Dad? It's Me, Hercules


The fishy affair continue as Agatha helps Hades converse with a possible (or literal) catfish online.

It was legendary bro, you just had to be there!



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
10. The Pros and (Comic) Cons

ZEUS

(to Hera)

You spent ALL OF MY money on a frivolous cloak!

HERCULES dabs.

HERCULES

Cloak of INVINCIBILITY! YEEZY, BABY!

ZEUS

I refuse to carry out upholding my alimony duties if you're going to squander it on 'a Jizzy Jacket' and other such nonsense!

HERA

The sound of inhalation, bubbles from a bong.

PAN OUT to POSEIDON and HADES on two chairs on the side.

POSEIDON exhales a huge cloud of smoke.

POSEIDON

What is 'incest?'

AGATHA

This is Feuding Families, not Family Feud! I think you're thinking of Jeopardy...

HERCULES

(on Instagram live)
Whaddup, HercJerks? I'm on my homie
Dr. Gil's show talking about my
family--- yo fam is a trip but at the
end of the day I'm hashtag blessed to
have them, namsayin?

ZEUS

This is preposterous! Look at him, he's a fat failure of a man!

HERCULES weeps from under his shutter shades.

HERA

It's just baby fat! He'll grow out of
it!

HADES

Anyone would be so lucky to have this...darling boy as a son. If I had a son...

ZEUS

You have dozens of sons!

HADES

None of which I had with my own sister...

Audience GASPS.

HADES

Unlike you, a deadbeat dad who won't own up to the responsibility of their inbred.

AUDIENCE boos. HERA stands up and throws her wine in HADES' face.

HERA

He's my inbred boy!
